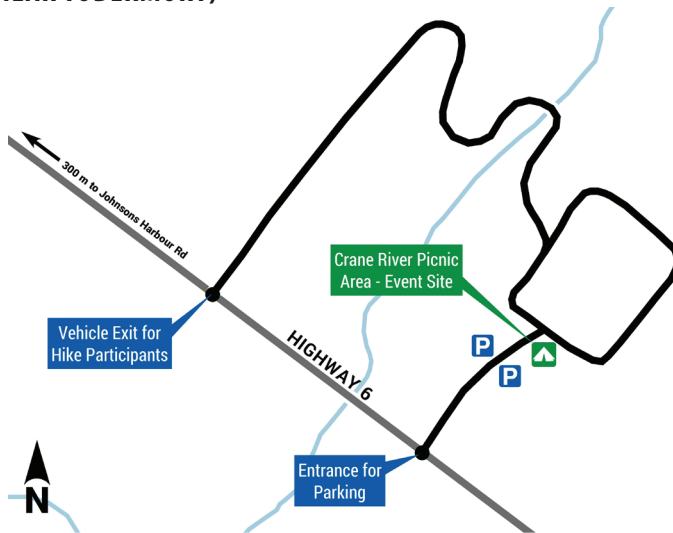

DRIVING DIRECTIONS FROM HIGHWAY 401:

Head west on highway 401 till you reach highway 410. Follow signs for ON-410/Brampton. Continue onto highway 410 north and keep left to continue onto Hurontario St/ON-10. Highway 10 merges with Highway 6 at Chatsworth. Continue north on Highway 6 past Owen Sound and follow it north to the Bruce Peninsula. The Crane River Picnic Area is approximately 85 km past Owen Sound; the entrance will be on your right.
